


Lumina




History of Daphine

In 1975 the skilled technician, Tommaso Cimini, was involved in electro-mechanical endeavors for prominent lighting companies in Northern Italy. Thanks to his creativity and background in mechanical engineering, he envisioned an easy-to-make, freely adjustable table lamp. Making the most of his manual skills and technical inventiveness, he developed the necessary models that led to the birth of Daphine. In 1977, Tommaso began to deliver the first Daphine lamps into the lighting showrooms of Milan.



to the two step switch function.










Above: 4W LED head Below: free rotation diffuser




